ORGANISATIONAL BACKGROUND

Proudly providing the communities of Western Victoria with opportunities to participate in indoor sports for over 40 years, Basketball Ballarat has grown and developed over this time into the organisation it is today.

In 2024 we boast a diverse and growing business which operates competitions across a range of sports for people of all ages, a successful hospitality business, a range of community programs and elite teams participating in national competitions that attract athletes from around the world. These current programs see 9,500 participants interact with Basketball Ballarat each week.

The organisation is based out of a recently built state of the art \$29.2 million 8 court indoor sports precinct, 3,000 Seat Show-Court, including a café, bistro/sports lounge, commercial gym, consulting suites and 4 outdoor 3x3 basketball courts. This, along with the privately owned 4 courts at the Minerdome provide the community of Ballarat and Western Victoria with all they need to participate in indoor sports.

PRIMARY PURPOSE OF POSITION

The Head Coach [Women's or Men's] will develop and sustain a strong core group of athletes and coaching staff for the Youth [Women's or Men's] Program to compete in the Big V Youth Competition. Whilst building a pathway for our Victorian Junior Basketball League athletes, the Youth Program is a critical further pathway for players into the NBL1 South, this position must have a clear holistic vision of now and the future.

This position plays a key part in supporting the guiding and implementing the philosophy, performance standards and coaching strategies for these teams.

SKILLS & ATTRIBUTES

- Be of good character and be willing to submit to a National Police Certificate check and hold a current Working with Children Card
- Be a positive and proactive voice for the sport in Ballarat and Greater Western Victoria Region

- Proficiency in the use of Microsoft Suite and general computer skills
- Proficiency in the use of Video Editing including Hudl
- Great communication skills, friendly, approachable and willing to listen – must be able to communicate and deliver the program and be a marketable public speaker
- High level organisational and management skills (personal and program)
- Sound administration and report writing skills; relevant to position
- Provide leadership and quality control of all programs you are responsible for
- Able to work within a team environment including all staff
- Capable and willing to make decisions within areas of delegated authority
- Must have a positive approach which is reflected in their coaching techniques
- Be able to demonstrate and use authority and initiative balanced with a practical and common-sense approach
- Be able to mentor and develop a broad range of athletes and coaches and to facilitate support services where necessary for athletes “at risk”. In the case of players Under-18 years of age, this will involve liaison and discussion with parents on player workload.
- A proven background in sports coaching and program development and be able to display a minimum level knowledge of the curriculum to be taught
